27 August 2007: 450 extended to run Hurstville – Strathfield – Sydney Olympic Park.

- 447 replaced by rearranged 941 & 942, new 946 & S14 & existing 914.
- Hurstville Strathfield part of 450 extended to run Hurstville Strathfield Burwood.
- 451 replaced by parts of 450, 941 & 942.
- New 939 Bankstown Greenacre via Noble Av commenced.
- 940 altered to run via Riverwood (*not* via Roselands).
- 942 altered to run Campsie North Belmore Lakemba Roselands Lugarno (Cedar St).
- 944 altered to run Bankstown Roselands Riverwood Mortdale Hurstville.
- 945 extended to run Bankstown Mortdale Hurstville.
- New 946 Bankstown Greenacre Hurstville commenced.
- New 955 Hurstville Mortdale commenced.
- New S14 Lakemba Mt Lewis commenced.
